

Communication and Language

- Show and tell with shoeboxes.
- Learning to listen to others.
- Listening to stories and answering questions about the story.
- Can use appropriate vocabulary when discussing favourites, family members, the body, senses and feelings.
- Joining in when singing songs and recognising patterns in songs and rhyming words.
- Responding to two part instructions.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Making new friends in the class and taking turns.
- Learning and helping to create the rules of the classroom.
- Learning school routines.
- Thinking about the things I like and do not like.
- Taking care of personal hygiene.
- Choosing own learning independently.
- Learning about my senses - what can I hear? Etc.
- Thinking about my feelings and how to recognise other's feelings.

Physical Development

- Beginning to get dressed by myself in PE.
- Multi skills activities in PE.
- Developing good pencil and scissor grip using funky finger activities.
- Using bikes and scooters.
- Becoming aware of my senses
- Learning about hygiene and hygiene routines and why they are important.
- Becoming aware of how to be safe moving around the classroom and outdoor area.

Literacy

- Learning to recognise and write name.
- Phonics activities Phase 1-2 Letters and Sounds incorporated with Jolly Phonics.
- Beginning to blend and segment the sounds we know.
- Taking a reading book and library book home.
- Exploring the book corner.
- Beginning to mark make and emergent write using writing frames.
