<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>In Spoken Word, the children will be encouraged to listen carefully and to speak out clearly. They will be learning to read with pace and to relate the content to their own experience. They will revise a wide range of sounds and practice using them to read and spell words. We will be hearing and writing our own fairytales, learning how to write formal letters for purpose, writing our own Superhero stories, hearing and writing poems about nature, as well as traditional rhymes and riddles. We will also read and write information texts about animals.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>The children will be following the Come and See scheme. Topics this term will comprise of Holidays and Holy days (the coming of the Holy Spirit) Being Sorry, and Neighbours (near and far) We will also learn about the Muslim faith.</p> <p>We will be praying the morning, before/after lunch and evening prayers so please help your child to become familiar with them. They are in the St Peter's Prayer booklet. Please ask if you require one.</p> <p>We will also continue to learn about St Francis, our class Saint.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> <p>The children will continue to count in ones, twos, fives and tens to 100, learning about place value. They will be adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing and solving simple problems. We will be looking at 2D/3D shapes, measuring in standard units and recognising and using coins and notes. They will be learning about time and how to read and write o'clock, half past and quarter to and quarter past times.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Animals including Humans The children will learn to sort animals into simple groups, including groups based on animal diets. We will describe animal bodies using relevant vocabulary. Children will learn the difference between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.</p> <p>Marvellous Materials Children will be asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways.
