Pupils arriving late or leaving early: Many of you will have already used the signing in screen in our main reception over the past year when you have visited school. We are now using this to sign in pupils who arrive late or need to be collected early for any reason. It is very straight forward to use. By selecting 'Pupils', 'Year Group' and 'Class' you will be able to find your child by selecting the first letter of their first name and select a reason such as 'medical appointment', 'transport issues' etc. This information then feeds



back into our registers electronically. Thank you for your cooperation whilst we embed this new way of recording attendance.

Pupil Data Sheets: Today you will be receiving a Data Sheet for your child. This enables us to update our records both electronically and in the contacts folder which we use to contact you if your child has had an accident or become unwell at school. Please can you check and update - including your email addresses and return to us by Friday 27th September at the latest. Even if there is no change, please sign and return. That way we won't keep sending new ones for you to check.

Parents of children in Reception will also be receiving photographic consent paperwork to be returned in the same timeframe please.

Catering - Ordering Meals - Deadline Reminder and Gluten Free and Halal Options: Please remember that the cut off for ordering meals for next week is 11.30pm on Saturday evening. If your child requires a Gluten Free or Halal option, please indicate this when ordering online. That will appear on the order the catering team receive when preparing the meal and on the list we receive in school so that staff can ensure they are given the correct colour wrist band. Following a conversation with Impact Catering please double check your child's statement to ensure that you have been correctly charged.
