- 1) The Magic Paintbrush-Julia Donaldson (Own version 'overcoming' tale)- thought bubbles, labels, oral retelling, writing in role, thank you letters
- 2) Little Red- Lynn Roberts (alternative character version)- labels, notes of advice, adverts
 - Beginning to write a full sentence in writing.
 - Practicing forming letters correctly in handwriting sessions.
- Guided reading (3x a week) answering questions about a text, telling own stories.
- Becoming confident at blending and segmenting during reading and writing.
