<p>English Kindleswyde This wintry fable is reminiscent of traditional fairy tales such as The Snow Queen featuring a cast of characters children will easily engage with. Children will write a shared poem, diary entries, persuasive posters, letters of explanation and newspaper articles.</p> <p>Escape from Pompeii This text engages children with the genre of historical fiction and links with topics of ancient Rome and natural disasters. Set against the backdrop of the eruption of Vesuvius in AD 79, it helps bring the topic to life and provides children with a rich background knowledge of a significant historical period.</p>	<p>RE The Christian Family- a Journey through Christ The children will acquire the skills of assimilation, celebration and application of the above.</p> <p>Listening and Sharing-Jesus gives himself to us The children will be exploring why Christians listen and share with one another. In addition, they will be listening to the Word of God and sharing in Holy Communion.</p>	<p>Science Light and Shadow Throughout this topic, the children will learn how we use light to see objects. They will learn about reflective materials, levels of transparency and how to protect their eyes from the sun.</p> <p>In addition, they will plan and carry out investigations to test the transparency and reflective qualities of a variety of materials.</p>	<p>Maths Multiplication and division- part b Applying multiplication and division facts to solve a variety of real-life problems and equations. Year 4 will move onto written methods.</p> <p>Length and Perimeter year 3 Measure in metres, centimetres and millimetres. Equivalent lengths, adding and subtracting lengths. An introduction to perimeter.</p> <p>Length and Perimeter year 4 Equivalent lengths, finding missing lengths of rectilinear shapes and finding the perimeter of polygons.</p> <p>The children will also be quizzed on their times tables daily.</p>
